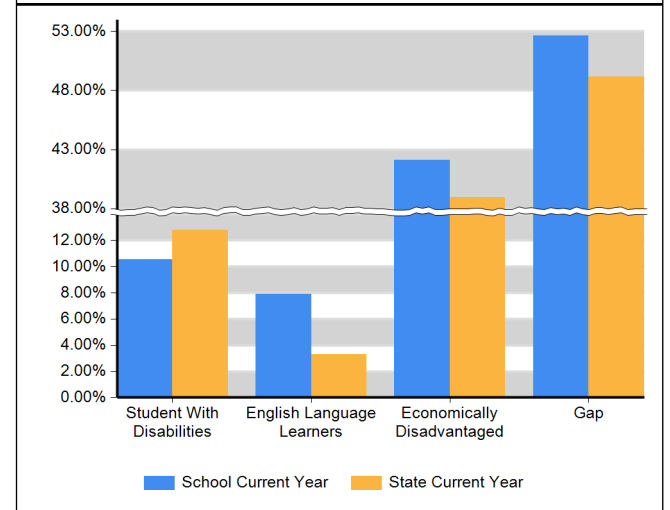

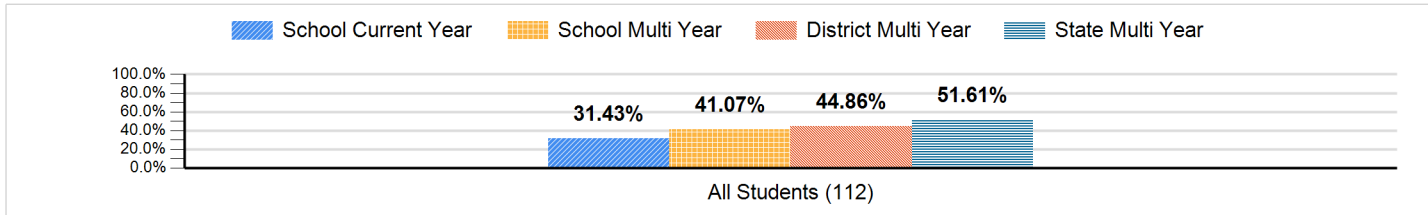
Student Population

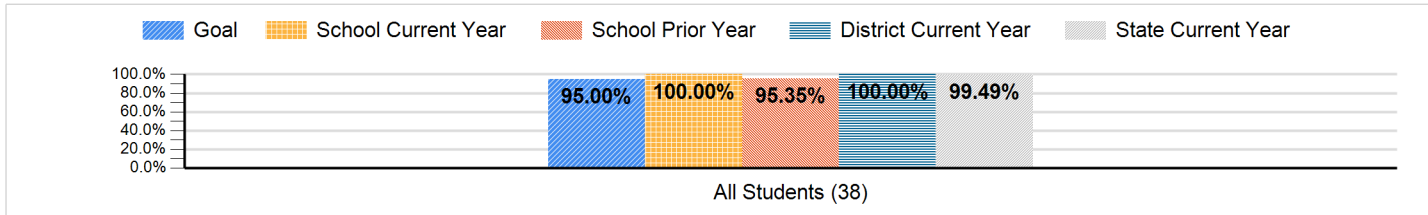

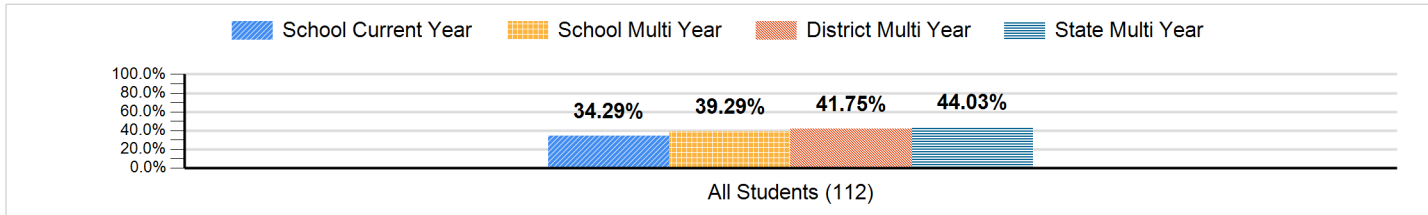

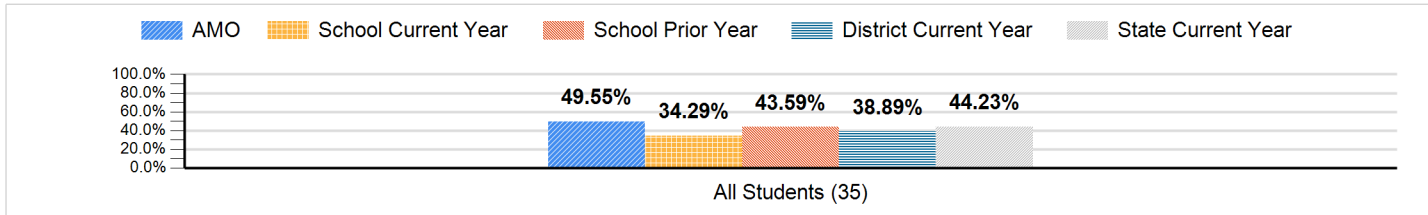

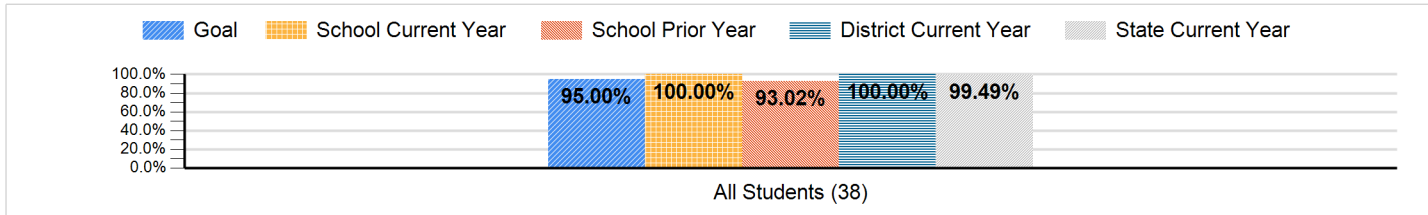

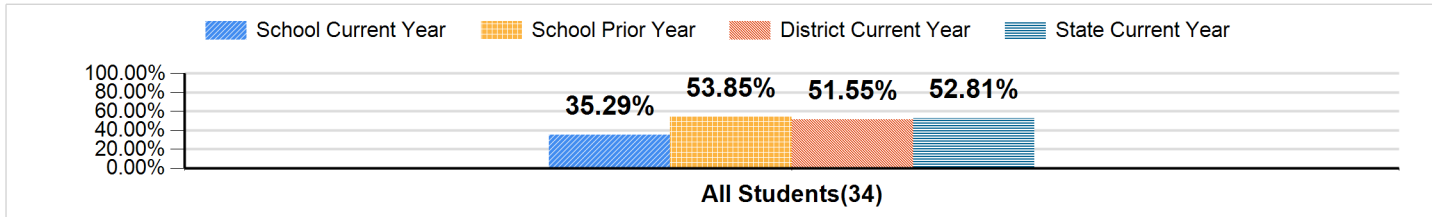

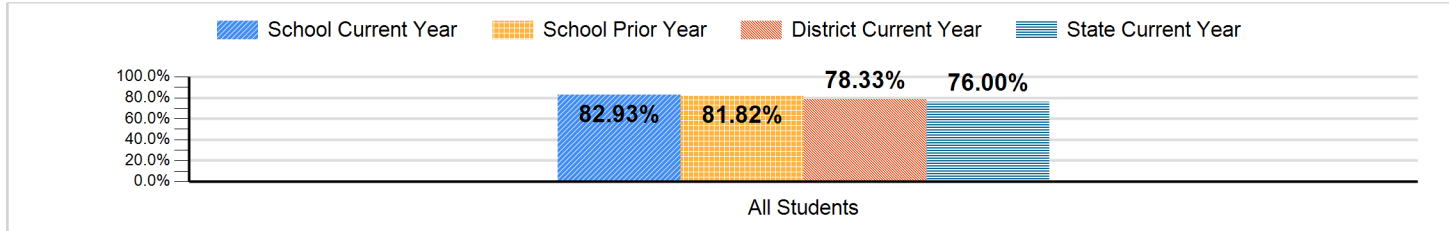
